The Credit Union requires all Qualified Written Requests (QWR) and "error" notices be mailed exclusively to P.O. Box 608 Bynum, AL 36253. The disclosure of this address is provided annually to the membership and at loan closing.

#### A QWR OR ERROR NOTICE INQUIRY MUST BE:



3

In writing, submitted by the member or an agent of the member (writing on a payment coupon or mortgage statement may not be considered as a notice of error); and

Include or provide enough information for the Credit Union to identify the name and account of the borrower; and

Contain a statement of the reasons the member believes that the Credit Union has made an error or contain a detailed explanation as to other information relating to the servicing of the loan.

## SKIP YOUR DECEMBER OR JANUARY LOAN PAYMENT(S)

By participating in AOD Federal Credit Union's Skip-A-Pay\* program, you authorize AODFCU to defer your loan payment(s) as indicated. You agree and understand that: 1) Mortgage loans, Credit Cards, and Ioans newer than two (2) months may not be eligible for the skip-a-payment program; 2) Payments made through Payroll Deduction or Automatic Transfer may be deposited into your Share Savings or Checking Account for the unpaid balance during the month you skip your payment and when payments resume, the unpaid interest will be collected first; 4) Deferring your payment will result in your having to pay higher total FINANCE CHARGES than if you made your payment as originally schedule(5) 5) The payment deferral may extend the maturity date of your loan(s); 6) You will be required to resume your payments the following month; 7) No more than two (2) payments per loan may be skipped in a calendar year. 8) Payment protection and/ or GAP insurance may not apply to the extended ban term. Certain restrictions may apply. The offer expires December 31, 2023 for December 2023 skips and January 31, 2024 for January 2024 skips.
